

The original creations of POEZ Jewellers stems from Malaysian-Taiwanese designer Poesy Liang's passion for gemstones, which has resulted in fine jewellery that embodies old-world elegance yet are stylish enhancements to everyday wear





GIVE HER CARTE BLANCHE AND SHE'LL design a jewel that's unique and charged with inspiration. Designer Poesy Liang's creations are crafted with passion and reverence, a showcase of unique settings where gold and platinum are the building materials that house uncommonly hued stones, the "rare and exquisite art of nature". Her jewels are pieces of wearable art sculptures that symbolise ingenuity, architectural expression and timelessness.

A classical foundation in traditional art and studies in architecture engineering shape Liang's design approaches. She says, "I tackle the creations with structural solutions. It was an advantage initially that I was not entirely exposed to the common ways to mount stones. My ways were more similar to dealing with the gravity and aesthetics of a building facade."

DESIGNS

There is a story behind each of her jewels, inspired by people she has met, moving accounts or the gemstones themselves. Take for example the Taj Mahal-inspired Le Taj rose gold ring featuring a pink tourmaline and red spinels, rare stones that draw a parallel to the Mughal Emperor's devotion for his beloved late wife. The ring structure is the abstract interpretation of the architecture wonder's magnificent elevation. Liang relates, "Sometimes an idea will just come to me and I will match it to the best stones for a new creation, or sometimes certain stones instantly do the talking before an



popular for mother-folks. The Andersen cufflinks design came from the special commission by a European lady as a surprise for the 70th birthday of her wonderful husband. The Pink Debutante may be offered to a girl coming of age, while the Signature-C Pink Sperm symbolizes fertility in every sense of the word. Naturally, there are many more creations from which to choose.
